On Tuesday 12th November 2024, our Stage 4 and 5 Women in STEM students represented the program at the 2024 Young Business Minds Awards.

Stage 4 students: Ameliyah, Kayella, Sophia & Mikaylee were recognised as the runner-up in the Under 25s category - Business Enterprise, with their company EcoVolt Drive. These students have build a functional prototype of a thermoelectric generator which can sit between the engine and the bonnet, utilise the seedbeck effect, and power the vehicle by the electricity generated in the temperature difference - futuristic renewable energy.

Stage 5 students: Laniaia, Sommer, Khalia & Lotus were recognised as the runner-up in the Under 25's category - Social Enterprise, with their initiative YIPACs. These students have a financial investment from Regional Bank Australia to fund their initiative, as well as are backed by Maitland City Council, and the Hunter IF as a Youth Advisory Board for the region.

Stage 5 student, Khalia, was additionally awarded as the winner in the Under 25's category - Creative Industries, with her business Coastal Currents Co. Khalia built a full scale 7" bamboo biodegradable surfboard, with ecofriendly resin + wax. Khalia was interviewed by ABC Radio on Thursday 21st November 2024. Khalia spoke about her company and is now seeking financial partners for her business.

A very big congratulations to all students involved, along with staff member, Ms Jade Bassett, for all of her commitment, dedication and support of the RTHS Women in STEM program.




#### **TAS FACULTY REPORT**




#### **Before school**


- Schoolwork access is from 8:20am each morning.

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
